



Electronic Recyclers International CEO Featured on "Going Green" Radio Show

John S. Shegerian, Chairman and CEO of Electronic Recyclers International (ERI), the nation's leading recycler of electronic waste, was featured as an in-studio guest on Sacramento-based KDEE-FM's "Going Green Radio Show with EnviroBro," hosted by Leonard E. Robinson, Federal Liaison to the California Environmental Protection Agency's Department of Toxic Substances Control and the radio host known as "EnviroBro the hardest workin' man in the environment."
